With this offer we would like to welcome you to Hamburg and kindly greet you at the Hamburger Kunsthalle!

The Welcome Ticket is available at the cash desk at the main entrance of the Hamburger Kunsthalle. Free admission is also available for one accompanying person each.

For free admission, it is sufficient to present a valid residence permit in accordance with Section 24 AufenthG or Section 25 (1, 2 or 3) AufenthG or in each case in conjunction with a temporary residence permit from the Foreigners' Registration Office. If you are from Ukraine, the presentation of a Ukrainian passport or other identification document is valid.

Advance registration is not required as long as the group is smaller than eight people. This only applies to groups without a tour request.
